Exhibition Terms and Conditions

Annual Members Exhibition 2026
@ SOCIAL Gallery, Salamanca Place, Hobart
16th until 28th September 2026

Theme: Elemental

Conditions of Entry:

1. Each member is entitled to submit up to **three** works (or sets) per member.
Please number your artworks clearly as they will be displayed in order.
2. The entry fee is \$20 for 1 artwork, \$35 for 2 artworks and \$50 for 3 artworks submitted.
3. Work cannot be accepted from non- financial members.
4. **Packaging of Artworks for Delivery:**

All entries must come packaged in a BOX.

Bags and unwrapped work are unacceptable.

This rule is in place to reduce the risk of breakage during set up and shut down and packaging for buyers.

All entries must include the following:

- Your work packaged in safe materials and placed in a box with your name and details clearly printed on the outside. (This box can then be used if a sale is made of your work so it's a good idea to **pack it like it's sold** with your contact details and business cards etc).
- All entries must have a printed copy of your Entry Confirmation email enclosed.
- If you require specific installation of your work - please include an image of the set-up with detailed instructions.
- If your work has a complex setup process, we require that the artist be available to install their own work during the installation of the exhibits.

5. Exhibition Curation:

- Your entry must be of a suitable exhibition standard – that means no cracks, loose or broken pieces, no glue or blue tack. All wall hung items must have suitable hanging fixtures. We have Exhibition Wax on hand to stabilise your work if required. Please be mindful that we will not accept your work if it is damaged in any way. It is unacceptable to consider selling an exhibit that is not to standard. All items exhibited must be for sale.
- Please be understanding of where your work is situated during the exhibition. It is impossible to please everyone with the location of their work within the exhibition and the volunteers put in a major effort to showcase each piece of artwork at its best.
- It is not acceptable for exhibitors to change their work's location during the exhibition and in turn move the work of other exhibitors. If you are extremely unhappy with where your work is situated, please contact the exhibition volunteers and make arrangements to consult with them regarding your concerns.
- Exhibits cannot be removed from the exhibition until the exhibition has officially closed unless the artist has specified that they have a replacement piece. If artworks are sold to interstate buyers, it is up to each artist to personally arrange delivery and costs with the purchaser unless they have noted a replacement piece. All packaging is stored in the small storeroom off the kitchen.

6. **Entry Forms** must be completed, or you can download a copy from our website and email it to enquiries@tasmanianceramics.com. The entry form has all your information regarding your entry – size, price, medium and Artist Statement. The TCA will invoice all exhibitors once entries have been finalised. Please be mindful of hand written entry forms – remember that someone has to type this information up – so make it clear and readable. You will receive an acceptance email and payment must be made with your details.

7. **Sales:** All work exhibited **must be listed for sale**. The TCA will deduct 20% commission from the total price of your submitted artwork if sold. This will be automatically deducted from your final price; please allow for this when pricing your submission. If you have chosen to display a second artwork once your first item has been sold, the entry fee + the commission will be deducted from your final total.

8. **Exhibition Details:** The *Elemental* exhibition will be open to the public at SOCIAL Gallery, SAC 67 Salamanca Place, Hobart on the Thursday 17th of September and run until Monday 28th Sept, opening from 10am until 4pm daily. (Bump out Monday Sept 28th – closing at 3pm).

9. **Opening Night** - The official exhibition opening and prize giving will be held on Thursday the 17th September @ 5.30pm – all TCA members will receive an invitation to this event – RSVP's are required as this is a ticketed event.
10. **Photographs** – All works included in this exhibition will be photographed and publicised online and the Association undertakes to correctly label these and promote each artist in relation to these images. Please note that we may use your photographs for future advertising purposes.
11. **Gallery Sitting Roster** – A condition of entry is that each member must submit at least two dates for the Gallery Sitting Roster when submitting their entry form. Gallery Sitting is a **requirement** for this exhibition unless you reside beyond 60 kms from Hobart.
12. **Setting up – Bumping In:**
Please advise if you can assist with setting up the exhibition – all help will be gratefully accepted. **All work for the exhibition must be delivered to the SOCIAL Gallery, 67 Salamanca Place, Hobart between 10am and 1pm on Wednesday the 16th of September.** Work submitted after these times will not be accepted unless prior arrangements have been made.
13. **Shut Down – Bumping Out:**
Please advise your availability to help shut down the exhibition. All works that have not been sold are to be collected from the gallery from 3pm on Monday the 28th Sept unless previous arrangements have been made. All uncollected art works will be left at the SAC Office.
14. **Loss and Damage** – The Tasmanian Ceramics Association bears no responsibility for any loss or damage to any works included in the exhibition.
